

Application Guidelines for a Faculty Position

The International Education Unit, Center for Promotion of International Education and Research, Faculty of Agriculture, Kyushu University, welcomes international applicants who eager to develop his/her career in education and educational management at the English Courses of Undergraduate School of Agriculture and Graduate School of Bioresource and Bioenvironmental Sciences, Kyushu University, Japan and hold distinguished research records in the field of Cell Biology and/or Molecular Biology.

1. Position and Affiliation

An associate professor position at International Education Unit, Center for Promotion on of International Education and Research, Faculty of Agriculture, Kyushu University

2. Job Descriptions

1) Education

A successful applicant will teach subjects as follows:

1.1) Undergraduate Program

Cell Biology, and Bioresource and Bioenvironment Experiments and Practice

1.2) Graduate Program

Agricultural Problem Based Learning I , II

1.3) Arts and Science Program for freshman students

Basic Laboratory Experiments in Natural Science, Fundamental Cell Biology,
and Introductory Cell Biology

1.4) There may be a few more courses dependent on some circumstances

2) Management of educational programs

A successful applicant will support for international affairs and international-students-related projects and coordination. The applicant will also develop short-term exchange programs with international partner universities.

3) Research

A research environment for the applicant is arranged depending on the specialty.

* Please note that 70% of its job is for work as a full-time associate professor of the International Education Unit and 30% for his/her own research.

3. The Position Starting Date

October 1, 2017

4. Required Qualifications

- 1) An applicant is expected to be a native English speaker or a fluent English speaker to teach subjects on Cell Biology and/or Molecular Biology in English-taught undergraduate and graduate programs.
- 2) An applicant must have a Ph.D.
- 3) An applicant is expected to have distinguished records of research in Cell Biology and/or Molecular Biology.
- 4) An applicant must have a nationality other than Japanese.

5. Term

- 1) This is a tenured position according to Kyushu University's regulations.
- 2) Kyushu University sets retirement system at the age of 65.

6. Application

Applicants should send the application documents listed below by email. All the documents must be sent as PDF formatted files. We do not accept applications by postal mail or by facsimile. All application documents must be received by 17:00 (Japanese Standard Time) on May 19, 2017.

- 6) Two letters of recommendation (in English or Japanese). Each letter must be directly sent to kyushu@agr.kyushu-u.ac.jp from the recommender's email account.

The actual amount will be determined in accordance with the Kyushu University's regulations, the successful applicant's past accomplishment and other factors. A relocation allowance will be provided based on the regulations of Kyushu University.
